Dear PhD Students 36th and 37th cycles,

I would like to inform you that the University, in collaboration with APRE, the Agency for the Promotion of European Research, has organised a training course, as part of the calendar of events planned for the year 2023, on the topic of "HORIZON EUROPE: *Research Infrastructures*. How to write a proposal".

The course will be held on **21 June 2023, from 09:00 to 13:00 a.m.,** via the Teams Platform. You will be provided with the access link to the platform.

It should be noted that <u>participation in the module dedicated to in-depth analysis of administrative aspects, from 12:00 to 13:00, is optional.</u>

The course will provide an overview of the Horizon Europe Work Program *Research Infrastructures* 2023-2024 with regards to the writing of a proposal.

Please note that, pursuant to Ministerial Decree 226/2021, the above-mentioned study day is part of the training obligations of PhD students enrolled in the **36th and 37th** cycles of PhD courses.

With regard to the above, <u>it is not necessary to enrol in the course</u>. <u>Only in case of impossibility to participate must the absence be justified by the PhD Course Coordinator</u>, for objective reasons only, <u>by 19/06/2023</u>, by e-mail to the following address: <u>HorizonEurope@unicampania.it</u>.

A certificate of attendance will be issued to participants upon verification of actual participation and passing the final test. In this regard, it should be noted that APRE will communicate to the University the data relating to participation in the course. To receive the certificate of participation, it will be necessary to have followed the course for at least 80% of its duration (from 9:00 to 12:00), while to receive the certificate of participation with passing of the final assessment, it will be necessary to have followed the course for at least 80% of its duration, and to have passed the final test with at least 80% of correct answers.
